Advanced Course of Study

Completion Requirements



The Book of Discipline requires completion of the 5 year Basic Course of Study and a minimum of 32 semester hours of graduate theological coursework, which must include Evangelism and United Methodist history, doctrine and polity.

GBHEM currently expects Advanced Course of Study students to complete the 27 hours of Basic Graduate Theological Studies as outlined in the Book of Discipline plus at least 5 additional hours.

Students must complete 33 semester hours to receive a record of completion from Garrett-Evangelical.
