Course Description:

This course is designed to help students engage Christian preaching and its Hebrew and Jewish antecedents with particular attention to the socially transformative themes of the Good News. This class will attend to the complex history of the contestation of social realities through Christian preaching, and it will emphasize traditions of preaching emerging from marginalized social groups that have critically addressed power. Students will be invited to engage diverse expressions of Christian proclamation including but not limited to pulpit preaching that can be deployed within broader communal life to pursue social transformation.

Course Outcomes:

As the student fulfills the requirements of this course, the student will learn to...

- 1. Reflect on the socially transformative themes of the Good News.
- 2. Define the nature, character, and contours of prophetic proclamation.
- 3. Engage leading voices in discourse on prophetic proclamation within the field of homiletics and beyond.
- 4. Identify their vocational role in relationship to prophetic proclamation and implications of that for their life and work.
- 5. Integrate strategic goals, benchmarks, and community assessment plans with a vision of how preaching might contribute to efforts for social transformation.
