ACTS PhD Cross-Registration Proposal

There are two ways to do PhD cross-registrations:

- 1. For a PhD student to cross-register with any ACTS seminary that offers a PhD degree we would use the current cross-registration form. PhD courses at:
 - o CTS 500 and 600-level
 - o G-ETS 800 and 900-level
 - o LSTC 500 and 600- level
 - o TEDS 7500-level and above (considered on a case-by-case basis)
- 2. For a PhD student to do an independent study with any ACTS professor including professors from the schools mentioned above:
 - The student consults the advisor and the director of PhD and/or Advanced Studies (following home school procedures for approval), registrar, and dean's office. A courtesy email between deans is expected.
 - o The student would contact the professor to discuss interest in an independent study.
 - o The ACTS deans have approved \$250 compensation for each student.
 - The student registers at the primary school, pays tuition to the primary school, and the independent study is registered at the primary school with the ACTS professor listed as instructor.
 - o If a master's level course is part of the PhD independent study, the student does not cross-register separately for the class but attends the class as part of the independent study arrangement.
