

CROSS-CULTURAL AND INTERNATIONAL STUDY - pre 2003

Because effective ministry in the global context requires cross-cultural understandings, all students at Garrett-Evangelical are expected to engage in some form of cross-cultural experience during their degree program. This expectation may be met through cross-cultural or international travel seminars organized by the seminary, usually during the January intensives; through field education placements; through other programs approved by the Cross-Cultural and International Theological Education Committee, or sometimes in special courses. For MDiv and MA students, integration of cross-cultural, international, or inter-religious experience is included in the evaluation check points. Information on programs and procedures are kept in the CITE office.
