

**DM744 Practicum in Spiritual Formation
January – April 2022**

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Focuses on the evolving challenges facing leaders engaged in spiritual formation, relying upon student projects as laboratories for defining and dealing with those challenges.

Direction Module Five: Practicum, including verbatims, in-class exercises, the integration of knowledge, and assessment of the student's direction skill

Four synchronous Zoom sessions plus weekly posts on Moodle.

Participants will engage in “leadership in spiritual formation/direction” by leading small group studies and/or retreats. From your leadership experiences, you will provide four (4) critical incident write-ups, on assigned topics, and three (3) book reports. You will also engage in five (5) one-on-one spiritual direction sessions. You are expected to develop some of your bibliography for the course, drawing from previous coursework in spiritual formation and spiritual direction, and suggested bibliography, to demonstrate competency in spiritual formation/direction, and resources that will support your Doctor of Ministry project.

Course Outcomes By satisfactorily completing all elements of the course, students will be able to:

- Assess their competencies in spiritual direction/formation leadership
- Develop their small group/retreat leadership skills in spiritual direction
- Develop their skills in one-on-one spiritual direction
- Describe the interface of spiritual formation/direction and other aspects of congregational life
- Develop the “literature in the field” chapter for their Doctor of Ministry project

Course Elements

- Provide “leadership in spiritual formation” through small groups and/or retreats
- Assess your knowledge/skills in spiritual formation/direction ministry
- Engage in five (5) one-on-one spiritual direction sessions with a classmate and write verbatims of your experiences. Two styles will be used, each will be described at designated Zoom session
- Develop your reading list of seven (7) books and provide book reports on three (3) books
- Provide four (4) Critical Incidents on themes provided
- Be in spiritual direction or monthly soul friend relationship
- Report on your personal spiritual practice and experience in spiritual direction
- Report on your leadership experiences
- Participate in four (4) Zoom sessions
- Post all weekly assignments on Moodle and respond to classmates as directed
- Final Paper will be the “literature in the field of spiritual direction” chapter for your Doctor of Ministry project

Weekly assignments

Complete by **Friday** each week (except as noted for our **Monday Zoom** sessions). Respond the following week to your class partner (partner will be assigned) and at least one other person.

Jan. 3-7, preparation assignment. Post your "Letter from God" and personal discernment issues **before** our Monday Zoom meeting (material from *Discerning Life Transitions* will be supplied on Moodle for this assignment).

Jan. 10, Week 1: Zoom meeting, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. CST. Introduce yourself reading your "Letter from God" and describing your personal discernment issues. Also, be prepared to verbally describe your "leadership" in spiritual formation experiences planned for the course. We will conduct a one-on-one spiritual direction experience during the Zoom session. Instructions will be supplied.

Jan. 14, Week 1: Forum post: Describe your "leadership" in spiritual formation experiences for the semester. We'll discuss this assignment verbally on our first Zoom meeting, Jan. 10... take a few days to refine and post on Friday, Jan. 14. Forum post: Description of your first one-on-one spiritual direction experience.

Jan. 21, Week 2: Use "Components of Spiritual Guidance" for self-assessment and pick your additional books; post online. Include a schedule for your three book reports. Suggested reading to begin: Dwight Judy, *A Quiet Pentecost: Inviting the Spirit into Congregational Life* and Adele Ahlberg Calhoun, *Spiritual Disciplines Handbook*.

Jan. 28, Week 3: Write first Critical Incident using an individual encounter that is like spiritual direction. Clarify plans for your leadership in spiritual formation leadership experiences. Post outline. Conduct a second one-on-one spiritual direction session with your partner at mutually agreeable time.

Feb. 4, Week 4: Post first book report on one of the books that you are reading. Post description of your second one-on-one spiritual direction experience. Read *Discerning Life Transitions* (Ch. 2), again in preparation for our Zoom meeting, Feb. 7. Be prepared to lead one of your group exercises with a cluster of your classmates for our Zoom meeting, Feb. 7.

Feb. 7, Week 5: Zoom meeting, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. CST. During the meeting, you will work with a partner in one-on-one spiritual direction with a new verbatim format. Instructions will be provided. We will also work with hero/heroine journey material from *Discerning Life Transitions*. You will also guide one of the exercises you plan for your Leadership in Spiritual Formation with a cluster of your classmates.

Feb. 11, Week 5: Post write up from your third spiritual direction session. Also, post second Critical Incident using an experience in worship leadership.

Feb. 18, Week 6: Post update on your experience with “leadership in spiritual formation” or with your planning and questions that are arising for you. Set up your fourth spiritual direction session with your partner.

Feb. 25, Week 7: Post your second book report. Post description of your fourth spiritual direction session.

Mar. 4, Week 8: Write third critical incident using experience in your group leadership in spiritual formation.

Mar. 7, Week 9: Zoom meeting, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. CST. During this meeting you will work with a partner in one-on-one spiritual direction. **Dr. Rodolfo Nolasco** will join us 10a.m.-12 noon, with discussion of his book *God’s Beloved Queer* and issues of spiritual direction with queer community. We will discuss Ethical Guidelines of Spiritual Directors International.

Core Competencies for Certificate in Spiritual Direction

As the capstone course for the Certificate in Spiritual Direction studies, Doctor of Ministry students should expect to have competency in the following areas:

1. Regular practice of spiritual disciplines within their own lives.
2. Regular engagement in spiritual direction for their own development.
3. Ability to teach others diverse spiritual disciplines and practices (including, but not limited to, *lectio divina*, various forms and types of prayer, confession and examination of consciousness, processes of discernment, leadership of worship, fasting and self-emptying, ways of hospitality, Myers-Briggs Type Indicator, Enneagram).
3. Understanding of and engagement in the essential link between spiritual direction and congregational leadership (e.g. in worship leadership and preaching, Christian education, pastoral care, community outreach, mission and evangelism, church administration, ecumenical and interfaith dialogue).
4. Knowledge of and ability to teach history and practices of Christian spirituality.
5. Knowledge of interface between spiritual direction and pastoral counseling practice, including knowledge for referral of spiritual direction clients for counseling issues.
6. Ability to relate Christian spirituality to interfaith conversation.
7. Ability to offer spiritual direction, both in one-to-one and in small group or retreat modes.

Use the following themes to assess your present ministry of spiritual guidance and areas for further development.

1. Areas of expertise in spiritual guidance. In what areas do you have a sense of personal competence and in which areas do you sense a calling for further study and growth in the areas noted below?

Critical Incidents

A “critical incident” report presumes no definition of what is critical for you; rather it encourages you to allow yourself the fullest latitude in recalling an event which, in whatever way it is important, seems to typify your recent experience in spiritual guidance/companionship. A critical incident may be a personal involvement that may have caused anxiety; it may be a description of a particular leadership experience; it may be an experience that points toward need for further clarification of skills or learning; it may be an event that was exceptionally gratifying. You will provide four (4) Critical Incidents on assigned topics.

In a 1-2 page report:

1. Describe the event including critical verbal and non-verbal communication, attending to your personal feelings about the situation and emotions you perceived in others.
2. What “tools” of spiritual formation/companionship/prayer/self-awareness did you use?
3. Is this a “low point,” “high point” or neutral for you? How might you have responded differently... what insights arose for you?
4. Deal with the question, “How do I understand or make sense of this incident theologically?” You may want to use a scripture reference.
5. What insight did you gain about your role in spiritual guidance/companionship?
6. What “growth points” or needs for growth did this reveal to you about your ministry of spiritual guidance/companionship?

List any other concerns or comments you may wish to add.

Final Paper

Your final paper for this course is the first draft of the chapter of your DMin project, "Literature Review of the Field of Spiritual Direction/Formation." You will begin by stating the primary topic that you will explore in your DMin Project, as related to the field of spiritual direction/formation. Develop a narrative of approximately 3000-3600 words (15-20 pages, double-spaced) showing how the theme of your project relates to current and historic literature in the field. Use this narrative to position your project as a unique contribution to the field. The primary resource of the literature will be bibliography you've attained through the coursework phase of the program, as well as your own research on your topic. Cite at least ONE contemporary or historic wisdom figure. Use G-ETS style manual for footnotes/endnotes and Bibliography.
